Indoor and Outdoor Shoes

Children require a pair of black shoes for outside play. (these can also be wellies in the winter)

Indoor shoes can either be another pair of black shoes or a pair of black pumps.

PE Kit

In the interests of health, comfort and safety, we require a change of clothing for P.E.:

- Dark shorts (Navy or black)
- White or School T-shirt
- Pumps or trainers.

Please make sure that everything is labelled.

Jewellery

• The wearing of jewellery is discouraged throughout school. For safety reasons, children with pierced ears may only ever wear studs which must be removed during P.E. If children are unable to remove and replace their studs themselves, they should not be worn to school on P.E. days.

Nail varnish and make up should not be worn.

Food in School

- Pre-School children can choose to have a school meal (currently £2.70 per day) or packed lunch.
- All Reception children are entitled to universal free school meals.
 Please let the office staff know if you do not want your child to have a school dinner.
- We do not allow Birthday cakes or sweets to be brought to school. We would encourage you to take part in our Birthday book scheme.
- Children are given fresh fruit or vegetables each day. There is no need to send a snack.
- Water is available all day. Milk is also available with the morning fruit snack.
- Children are encouraged to bring a labelled water bottle.

The First Week of School

Tuesday 5th September and Wednesday 6th September We intend to split the class into 2 sets of children (around 15 in each set). One set will attend on the Tuesday and one on the Wednesday. Both days will begin at the normal starting time. (8.45am-3.15pm)

Thursday 8th September All children attend school

Please sign up for one of the days. Maximum number each day will be 15.

- Your child will be given a Year 6 Buddy
- Their buddy will send them a picture and some information about themselves. We will send this via email or post.
- Their buddy will help them to settle into our school.
- They will take part in a variety of activities with their buddy during the year.


